All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

Attended Funeral – (Funeral Director’s charges only)

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Our Professional Service

This charge includes the following for all attended funerals:

Receiving your instructions regarding the funeral arrangements
 Completion of all legal and administrative arrangements
 Liaising with appropriate authorities

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death into the funeral director’s care
(Usually within 15 miles of our funeral home)

Care of the deceased before the funeral in appropriate facilities on our premises
 The deceased person will be kept at our St Albans funeral home

Conducting funeral with Funeral Director and all staff in attendance
(Usually within 15 miles of our funeral home in St Albans)

Providing a suitable coffin

Collection of ashes from Crematorium
(Usually within 20 miles of our funeral home in St Albans)

Administration of Charitable Donations

Disbursements (Fees that must be paid directly to third parties)

 for an existing grave with a memorial in place,
 you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee.
 In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.)*
